I'll Introduce You to Him • Acts 17:24-34 April 21st, 2024

- I. Paul told them about the greatness of God: He is Creator. (v.24)
- II. Paul told them about goodness of God: He is Provider. (v.25)
- III. Paul told them about the government of God: He is Ruler. (vv.26-29)
- IV. Paul told them about the grace of God: He is Saviour. (vv.30-34)

Take-Aways

- 1. Creation, Goodness and Government are good places to START when explaining God.
- 2. Salvation is the best place to END when explaining God.
- 3. Don't forget repentance and judgment.
- 4. Don't pull any punches.
- 5. One soul is worth the world!
- 6. Sometimes spiritual fruit is very slow coming. Don't give up.
- 7. God does save some wise, mighty and noble persons ... the "up and outs"!
