You love money ...

1. When you are not content with what you have. (v.6B)
2. When being godly and being like the Lord Jesus is not as attractive or as important to you as having money. (v.6A)
3. When you lose sight of the fact that money neither goes to heaven nor hell. (v.7)
4. When you mix up luxuries and necessities. (v.8)
5. When you are always greedy for more; and enough is never enough. (v.9A)
6. When the truth is that you experience temptations & traps & harmful lusts that are money-specific. (v.9B)
7. When money becomes an idol to you & destroys both your vertical relationship with God and your horizontal relationship with other persons. (v.9B)

3. What do the 7 diagnostics for loving money show you about your heart? Do you need to repent in any way to put money in its place?
