Psalm 2 & Select Scriptures

Psalm 2's conference in heaven is the only OT reference to the God the Father/God the Son relationship in the Trinity.

Psalm 2 is quoted in the NT by Hebrews 1:5-6 (referring to Christ's birth) and in Acts 13:33-34 (referring to Christ's resurrection).
